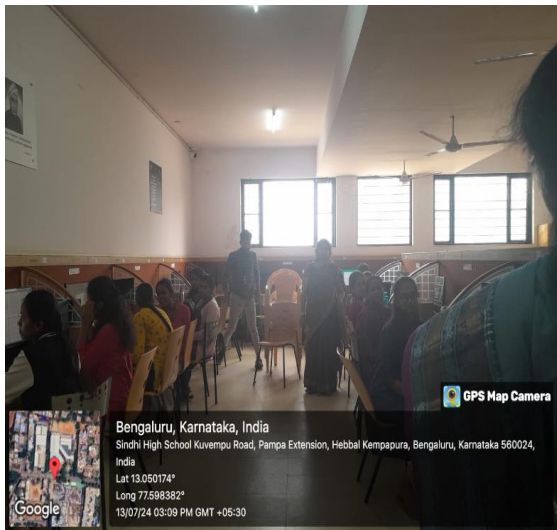


CENTRE FOR PG STUDIES

Sindhi College understands the importance of the same and has organised 8 days virtual FDP on topic very much relevant to the present trends, research titled “Quantitative data analysis using SPSS with interpretation and writing research article with AI from 14th to 21st June 2024. The program was organised in association with Primax.



DAY 1

Dr Aarthy from Christ University, Bengaluru was invited as the guest for the first day to talk on the basics of research. Dr Aarthy is very knowledgeable in the area of study. Mam spoke about the types of variables, types of data, and methods of data collection, different measurement scales used, identification of the problem, hypothesis setting, population, sampling and types, and statistical tools to measure the data.

DAY 2

Dr. Janani Ravinagarajan from VIT University, Chennai, was invited as the guest speaker for Day 2 to discuss SPSS. The session proved to be very beneficial as it was not just theoretical but also practical. All participants were instructed to install the SPSS software, which was provided by the organizers. Dr. Janani shared a dataset, and SPSS was utilized to analyze it. The session also emphasized testing the reliability of the data and validating the data collected. Day 2 was hands-on, with all participants actively using the software and learning.

DAY 3

On the third day, Dr. Arthi from Kristu Jayanti College chaired a session as a resource person. She is a distinguished expert in teaching and research, particularly in the area of hypothesis formulation and testing. The session offered valuable insights into the significance of hypothesis formation, which is a critical component of conducting research. Dr. Arthi covered various statistical tools, including one-sample t-tests, independent samples t-tests, paired t-tests, chi-square tests, and content analysis, along with reliability testing. This information helped participants understand how to effectively apply different statistical methods in their work.

DAY 4

Dr. Somsundaram from Kristu Jayanti College in Bengaluru focused on one-way and two-way ANOVA, as well as cluster analysis on the fourth day. These three statistical tools are among the most important for researchers, as they allow for the identification and exploration of underlying themes to explain the similarities or differences within the datasets being investigated.

DAY 5

Dr. Sathish from Christ University Bengaluru served as the resource person for the fifth day of the program. The topic covered was correlation and regression, which are statistical tools used for data analysis. The session included practical exercises where all participants actively engaged with the data and learned how to apply these statistical tools effectively.

DAY 6

Dr. Arthi from Kristu Jayanti College, Bengaluru, served as the resource person on the sixth day, presenting on the topic of mediation and moderation-based regression analysis. This tool is commonly used in clinical research to understand its operation and identify its existence. The

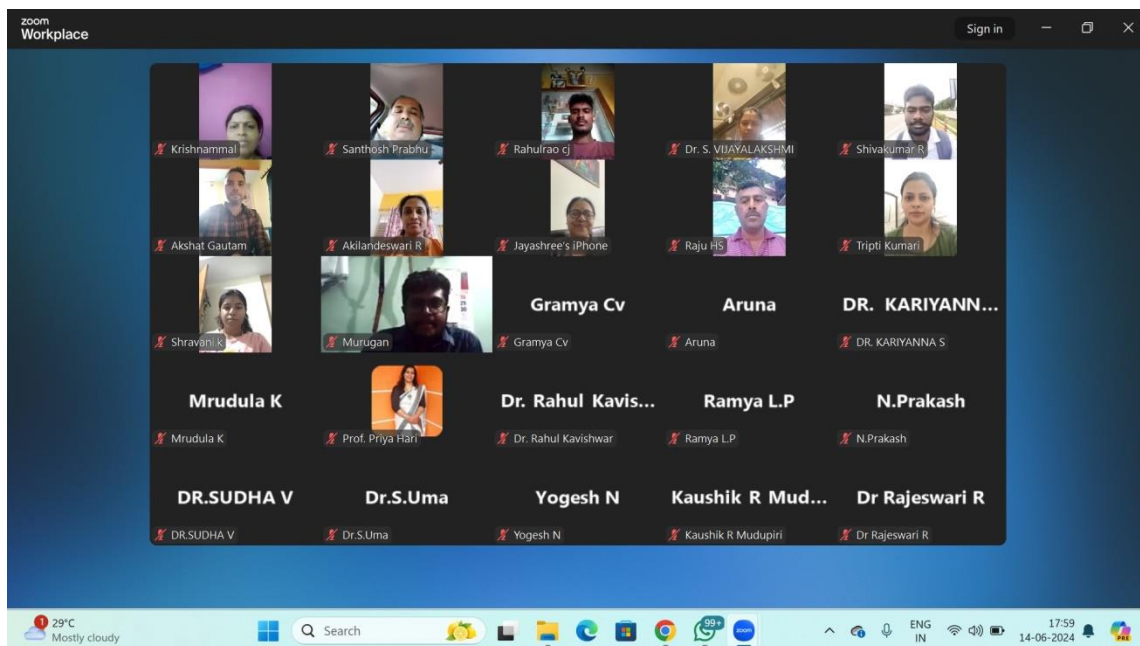
speaker provided an overview of the uses of this tool and discussed the types of data suitable for these analyses.

DAY 7

Dr. Sathish P. from Christ University, Bengaluru, was the resource person for the session on research article writing and journal selection. He provided in-depth knowledge on how to write an article and emphasized the importance of publishing it effectively. He discussed how selecting the right journals can enhance the article's credibility, focusing on identifying journals indexed in Scopus, Web of Science, and ADBC.

DAY 8,

Dr. Sowmiya Rani, Editor at Editage and Founder of Sowmis-AWW in Coimbatore, was the speaker for the final day of the Faculty Development Program (FDP). Her topic was "AI-Based Tools for Research Writing." As the use of AI continues to grow in various sectors, she explored its application in writing research articles. The session covered how AI can assist with research writing, data validation, formulating questions, conducting literature reviews, creating images for articles, and simplifying data analysis.



The eight-day sessions were collectively a very useful program for all research scholars and faculty members in writing quality articles. There was strong participation, with 138 participants from different institutions.

The objective of the workshop was to create awareness among students about the importance of copyrights in the age of AI and to help them understand the legal implications of using AI-generated works.



During a workshop, Ms. Mahima provided her insights on Copyright laws and policies, with a particular focus on AI-generated works. She explained the key principles of copyrights and how they apply to AI-generated works, along with the challenges and opportunities they present. The workshop had a total of 25 attendees from Sindhi College and Govt. R C College, consisting of M.Com and M.Com(FA) students who actively participated in the session. They gained valuable knowledge on the topic through the highly interactive workshop, where they had the opportunity to ask questions and clarify their doubts.
