Freshers' Day 2023



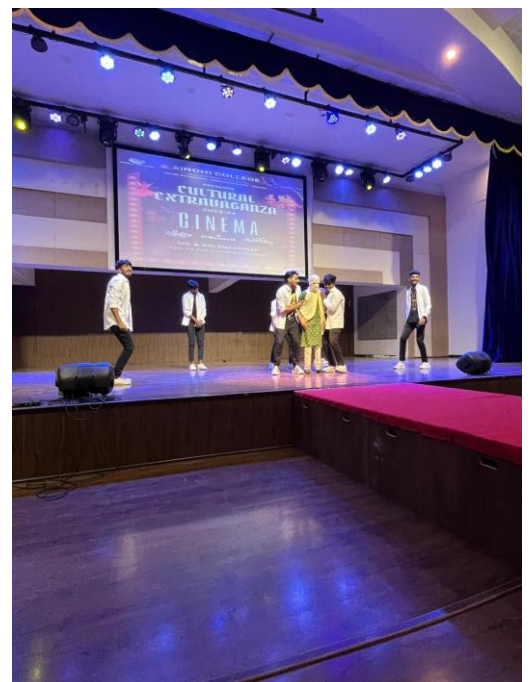

8-Day FDP: "Quantitative Data Analysis Using SPSS with Interpretation and Writing Research Article with AI"

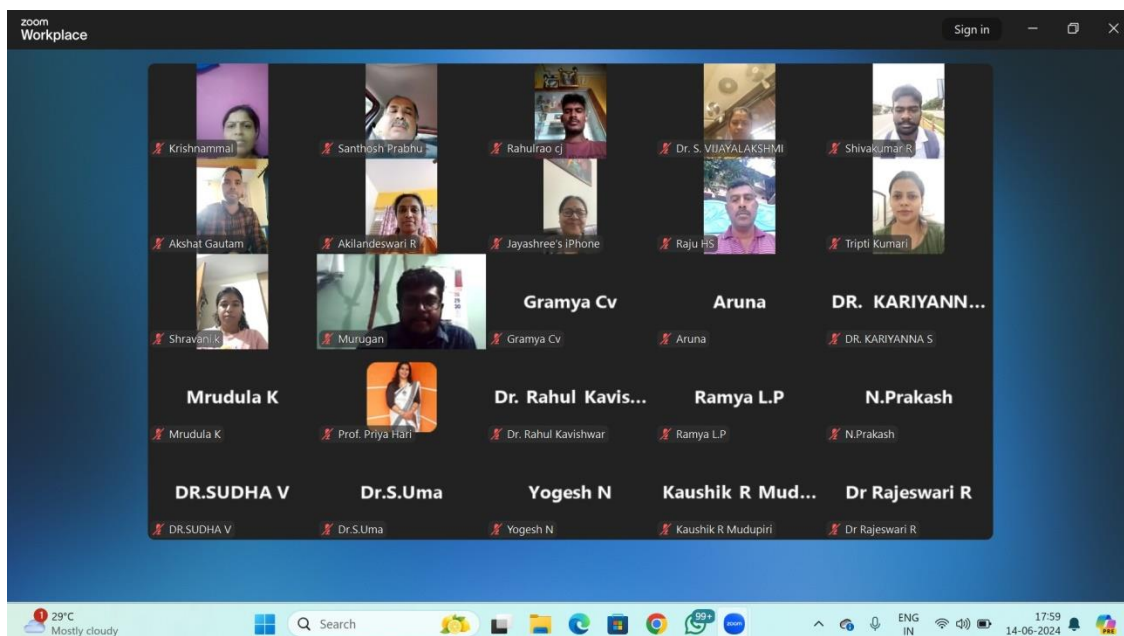
The Faculty Development Program (FDP) titled "Quantitative Data Analysis Using SPSS with Interpretation and Writing Research Article with AI" was held virtually from June 14 to June 21, 2024. Organized by Sindhi College in association with Primax, the FDP aimed to enhance the research writing skills and knowledge of faculty members. The program featured esteemed

speakers, including Prof. MR Gangadhar, Dr. Aarthi Chellasamy, Dr. Janani Ravinagarajan, Dr. K.S. Sowmiya Rani, Dr. Sathish P, and Mr. T. Somasundaram. A total of 138 participants, comprising 45 in-house faculty members, 11 students, and 82 participants from other institutions, attended the event.

The FDP covered various critical aspects of research and data analysis. On the first day, Dr. Aarthi Chellasamy laid the foundation by discussing the basics of research, including types of variables, data collection methods, and hypothesis setting. Dr. Janani Ravinagarajan led a hands-on session on SPSS on the second day, where participants practiced data analysis using the software. Dr. Arthi from Kristu Jayanti College delved into hypothesis framing and testing on the third day. Mr. T. 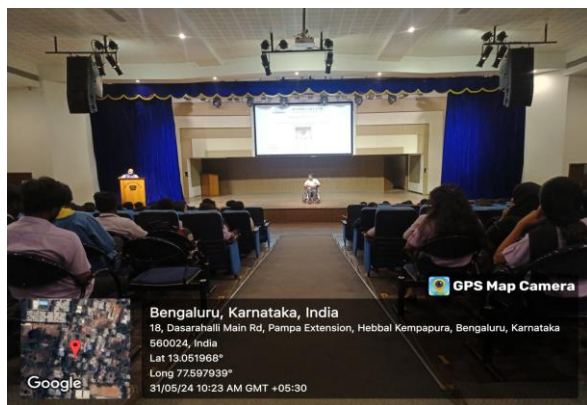

Exploring Career Opportunities after BBA

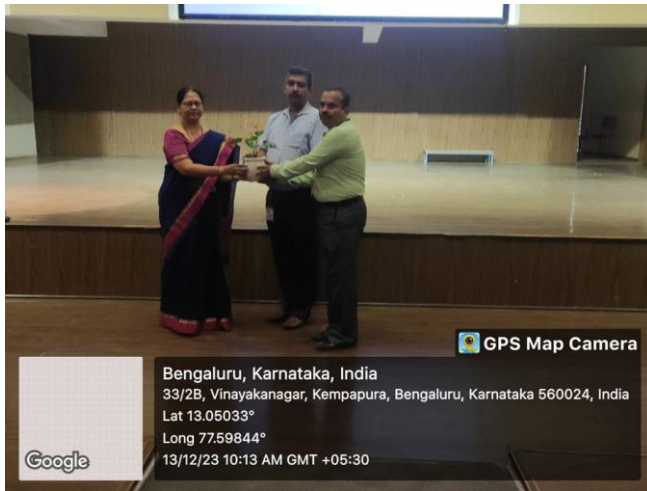

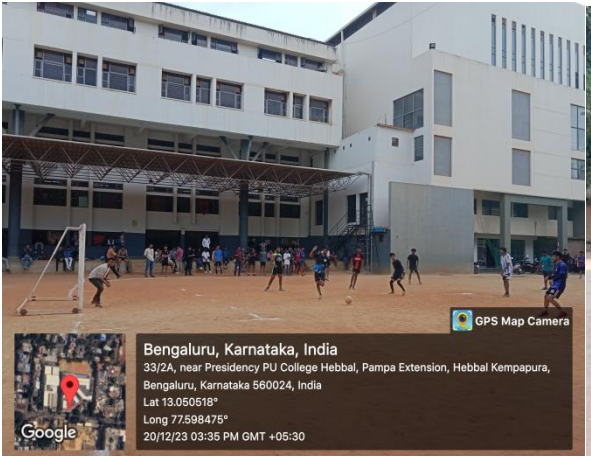


SPORTS AND NCC ACTIVITIES

The camp provided the cadets with valuable experience in drill practices and teamwork, showcasing their dedication and skill.

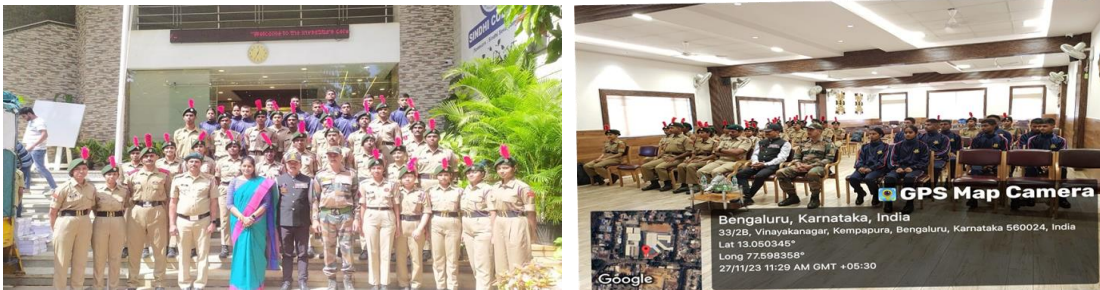
PRE RDC Camps (14th November – 3rd December 2023)

Brief Reports

Workshop on Data Analysis

Workshop on “Copyrights and AI”

On 5th February 2024, the IPR Cell in association with the Centre for PG Studies at Sindhi College organized a workshop on "Copyrights and AI," which took place in the Seminar Hall and was attended by 25 students, including those from Sindhi College and Government R C College. Advocate Mahima Meenaxi from the High Court of Karnataka led the session, focusing on the implications of copyrights in the age of Artificial Intelligence (AI). She began by explaining the fundamental principles of copyright law and how they apply to AI-generated content, discussing the legal complexities and future trends in copyright protection in the context of AI. The highly interactive workshop allowed students to engage in discussions, pose questions, and participate in hands-on exercises related to data entry, descriptive statistics, correlation, regression, chi-square tests, independent sample T-tests, one-way ANOVA, and comparative analysis. By the end of the session, participants had gained valuable insights into the practical applications of copyright laws to AI-generated works and were better equipped to address the legal challenges



associated with AI-generated content.
