Summary:

The students were given a warm welcome to visit one of the biggest hospitals at Mysore, JSS Hospitals which treats thousands of patients on a daily basis. The patients who come there are mostly from a humble economical class and the hospital caters very well without compromising the efficacy of treatment to the patients.

The students were channeled to visit the Clinical Psychology department which is headed by Dr. Manoj Kumar Pandey. The team of psychologists at the department addressed the students and introduced the different methods that are used to treat the psychiatric patients. The students were given a tour in and out of the department and were also allowed to visit few psychiatric patients who were kept in a highly secure ward for an experiential learning. Shortly after the tour, the team briefed about the different work practices that are involved while handling a psychological patient. and the variety of cases which may be challenging to the psychologists. This invoked the curiosity within the students to understand how to handle patients that are challenging and soon there doubts were addressed by different professionals effectively.

The last part of the visit, was a face-to-face session with the head of the department, Dr. Manoj Kumar Pandey, who spent a portion of his valuable time in addressing different questions that were posed by the eager-to-learn students. This session was definitely an icing on the cake moment as there were a lot of eye-opening learning. The speaker was so patient in trying to explain what Clinical psychology was all about, and what are the different challenges that are faced by the professionals in a day-to-day life and gave different case studies which indeed helped students get an -in depth understanding of the department, and career itself.


In conclusion, this field visit was really effective as most of the students had a clarity over the line of work they needed to get into in the future which was the very crux of this field visit.

Students were given an in-house tour, and also were briefed about important protocols while meeting patients. The students were also allowed to visit psychiatric patients who were kept in highly secure ward.







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

VISIT REPORT

RESONANCE OF VOICES

The Students of Journalism Department visited for an Industrial visit organized by the Department of Journalism on 13th Of September to a radio station known as 'Radiowalla' located in Vasanth Nagar. This Industrial visit was conducted to create an interaction with the Radiowalla and to understand how a radio station function.

All the students along with the faculty gathered inside at Radiowalla and were introduced to Mr. Harpreet Singh COO [Chief Operating officer] who gave a brief introduction about how radiowalla has a listener base of 14 billion people, in which it operates with 400 plus brands and 1400 plus locations also that they have a multiple player options like Windows, Web player and it has multilingual content from Kashmiri to Gujarati, Tamil to Telugu, Kannada to Assamese, Punjabi to Arabic. Then the students moved on exploring the soundproof studio and also got an opportunity to record and test their voice though it was the first attempt, the faculty and the members of radiowalla encouraged all the students.

Later, Students observed and understood the process of how advertising is prepared, evaluated and satisfies the clients assisted by Mrs Pinky Goklaney [Head of Accounting Department] who helped and encouraged the students of Journalism throughout the visit.

This visit not just gave students a practical exposure but inspired them to produce radio content







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
