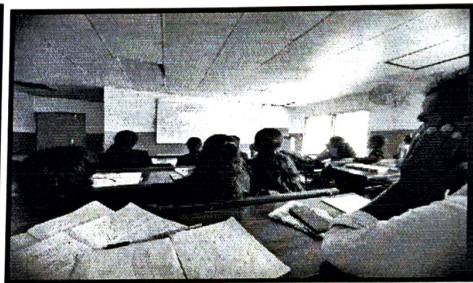
Topic: Live videos on Industrial Pollution
